

# PageSector <sup>TM</sup>

## Requirements -

Windows 10 or higher.

Thanks for using PageSector.

PageSector is a prefect choice for a strategy guide for a game, some story you want to read, certain source code files or any text file you have and would like to save your spot so you could come back to that point later. With PageSector its a breeze.

With PageSector you can open text files and save at any point in the text you wish by adding section names (book marks) You can label the section names, what ever you want. PageSector keeps track of the section names and where they correspond in the text, however it's not based on their label. Also PageSector keeps track of the files you have opened so you won't have to track them down again. You can even do a search in the opened text file.

Authors of any text file my want to distribute the Section file('s) with there text file('s), so users can see a list of topics, chapters, sections, etc.. and goto them with ease.

Programmers/Developers may find the bookmarking feature useful when viewing, edit or creating new source code files.

## How to:

### Open a file:

Click the Open button, control + O or via the file menu Open.

\*\*\* Note: Programmers/Developers can, as of version 3.9, open JavaScript, Java, C#, C/C++, PHP, HTML and CSS files and as of version 4.0 can open Python, JSON and TypeScript files. However PageSector does not do syntax colorization or formatting of code.\*\*\*

### Open a file from a web site:

Click the Web button, control +I or via the file menu Web and enter the complete location of the file. If PageSector can access the site, files are saved in: Documents/PageSector/Web/

### Save text:

After editing the text, click save(or File-Save, or control + s) to to bring up the Save as window.

\*\*\* Note: Programmers/Developers, if you click the New button and later wish to save, you will need to change the default file extension in the save window to the appropriate file extension for your code. \*\*\*

### **Editing Text:**

After opening a text file click the Locked button to unlock the text display to edit the text. (limited basic text editing)

\*\*\* Note editing the text may affect the bookmarks. \*\*\*

### **Create new text file:**

If there is text in the text area, just click the the New page icon and it will delete all the text from the text area and unlock it. Allow to create a new text file.

If no text is shown (i.e. you have not opened any files yet.) you can simply click on the unlock icon.

### **Add Sections (bookmarks):**

Highlight some text or just click in the text area, then you can either use the Add Button, control + B(or shift + control + b) or right click then Add or \*Auto Add. A window will popup asking you to enter a name, with exception to Auto Add. If you have highlighted some text, that text will be displayed in the name field. Click Ok to continue or Cancel if you do not want a section name. The name entered will appear in the list box.

\* If you choose "Auto Add" (by right clicking in the text area), it will be directly add to the Sections list.

\*If you press shift + control + B it will "Auto Bookmark", that is, directly place a bookmark in the Section list, provided you have selected some text.

\*\*\* Note - the bookmark name DOES NOT have to match anything in the text. \*\*\*

You can have as many section names as you wish.

### **Return to a section of text:**

Click on a name in the Sections list will take you to that spot in text.

### **Remove bookmarks:**

Click on one of the items in the list, then either click the delete button or right click then Delete or Delete All. Delete All will remove all from the Sections list.

**Saving Bookmarks:**

After adding or removing bookmarks, click the save button, control + s or goto File-> Menu and select Save. If you have not saved and go to quit the program or load a text file, a message will appear asking if you wish to save before you continue. Clicking Yes will do the save for you and continue, Cancel will continue and won't save.

**Edit Bookmarks:**

You can rename the bookmarks in the section list just double click, change the info then press enter. You can also rearrange the bookmarks. Just click and drag. Be sure to save when all done and it will save them in the order you have chosen.

**History Menu:**

As new text files are opened they get added to the History file. When PageSector opens it will list perviously opened files in the History menu. From there you can open those files. To delete items from the History, control + H (or goto Options and select Edit History) will bring up the History window, select an item from the list and press Delete . Once deleted, it will be gone from the History.

**Search:**

Pressing control + F (or go to the Options menu and select Find) will bring up a window to let you search for text within the file you are viewing. You must have opened a file before you can do a search. If you Highlight some text and do a find, that text will entered in the Find window for you.

**Change font size:**

The font size can be changed via the Font Size button or can set the default size in the preference window. Changing the font size may cause issues with bookmarks. Readjusting the size of the PageSector window my be required.

**Changing default window size, font and font size:**

Goto the Preference window(PageSector-> Preferences..., or control + , )

There you can change the default window size, font and font size for the text area and Sections list.

**Auto Adjust:**

If you have bookmarks and you resize the window and the bookmarks do not take you to the correct place, select Auto Adjust from the Options menu to adjust the window so the bookmarks will work correctly.

**Talk:**

Once you have open a text file you can have the text spoken to you. Either go to Edit-> Start Talking, or Control + T or right click on the test area and select Start Talking. In any case f you have highlighted some text, it will only speak what you have highlighted, if not it will speak all the text in the text area.

To stop the talking either go to Edit-> Stop Talking or command period or right click in text area and select Stop Talking.
